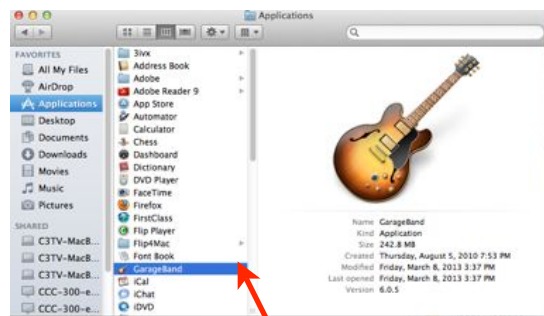


How to Record Your Voice in GarageBand '11

(or podcasts, storytelling, Voice of Democracy competition, etc.)

If using GarageBand at school in the mini lab, log onto the computer using the following:
log in name: imovie
password: imovie



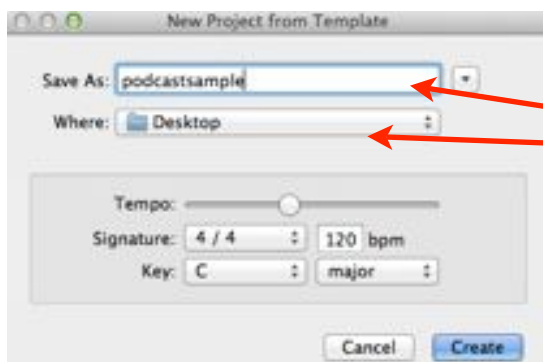
Open garage Band from the Applications Folder.



Select New Project.

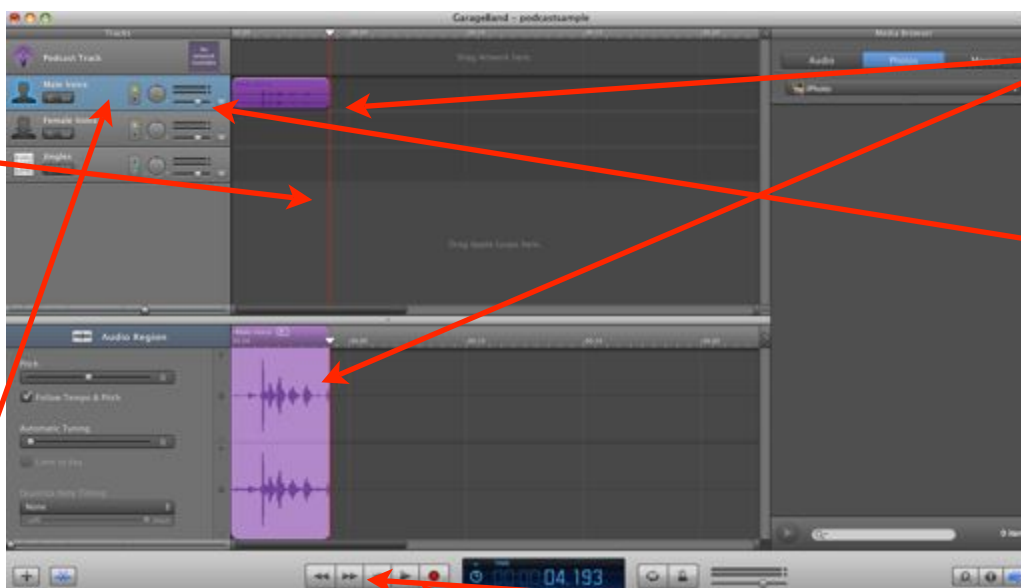
Select the type of project you want to create and the select choose.

Select podcast to record your voice



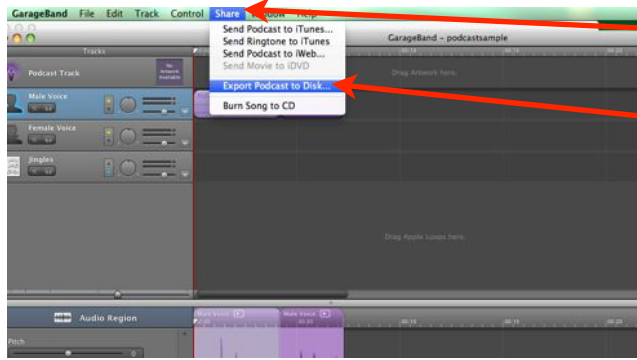
Name your podcast and choose where you want to save it.

Move this cursor when you are finished recording to the spot you want to listen to and select play or hit the space bar to hear the recording.



You will see the recording added to the podcast here as you are speaking. You can see the volume control of the recording here.

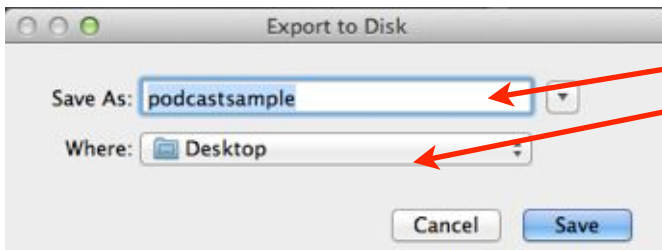
Select male or female voice. Click the record button and begin speaking. Select the stop button or hit the space bar to stop recording.



To finalize the recording, select Share>Export Podcast to disk



Select mp3 encoder



Name the file and choose where you want to save it.



The file will look like this when it has been finalized and saved. Burn this to a CD or save it on a flashdrive, etc.
